The Subject **الفاعل**

قرأ أحمد

- A noun.
- Like mobatada and khabar it is in a state of “rafa’” for example it acquires a “damma” on its last letter.
- It is an essential pillar of the verbal sentence (i.e. the sentence that starts with a verb) to indicate the doer of the action of the verb.
- It can be in the form of a pronoun (remember a pronoun is a type of nouns), for example:

قرأنا

Quranic Examples
